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Often parents ask what supplies are needed in the fourth grade. Students will all be provided with a pencil box. The lists below will help you if you wish to send additional items with your child.

This is a list of materials that each student in room 309 will use this year:

- one set of earbuds (for use with the iPads)
- 3 composition notebooks (for writing, science, and math)
- 1 sturdy one subject spiral notebook with at least 100 pages (for a homework planner)
- 2 sturdy one-inch three ring binders (for math and for literacy)
- 1 package (at least 5) tabbed binder dividers
- 6 sturdy plastic/poly two pocket folders (a variety of colors is helpful for students)

This is a list of materials that our class will share this year:

- 2 packages of 24 #2 yellow pencils
- 1 package of 8 or 10 broad line markers
- 1 package of 12 or 24 colored pencils
- 1 package of wide-ruled lined notebook paper
- 3 packages of yellow square sticky notes
- 2 plastic dispensers of clear tape
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 2 containers of Clorox wipes
- 1 package of Ziploc bags (snack, sandwich, or gallon sized)
